Guidelines For Accepting Monies

Effective October 1, 2006 this institution no longer accepts money orders for deposit in Inmate Accounts by any means other than through the U.S. Mail.

Money orders must not be enclosed with other inmate mail. If it is, the money order will be returned to sender. The maximum value of a money order accepted is \$60.00. Any amount over that will be returned to sender.

Only one \$60.00 money order will be accepted at a time.

Money orders must be payable to the inmate, including the inmates docket number.

The sender's name and address must be on the money order.

The envelope containing only the money order must be addressed in the following manner.

Inmate Account Office
Inmates full name and docket number
10451 Larkin Smith Drive

Gulfport, MS 39503

The sender's name and address must be on the envelope.

To send a letter, address the envelope to the inmate, including the inmates docket number, to the address above. Do not put Inmate Accounts on envelopes containing letters.

We now have a Kiosh Machine in the Lobby of the Detention Center and at the Work Center. You can place money on an inmate's account using cash or credit cards. There is a \$2.00 fee using this method. The inmate must already have an account sent up to use the Kiosh Machine.
